PROPOSAL FOR AFFILIATION BY NATIONAL COUNCIL
OF
SCIENTIFIC, PROFESSIONAL, ART AND WHITE COLLAR ORGANIZATIONS

The National Council has a mandate from the delegates attending the January Conference of the Professions. They are committed to provide active leadership on the program which the conference defined to meet the urgent problems before the professions.

Comparison with the Council's Conference findings reveals a similarity in scope and interest of the programs of the Council and National Citizens Political Action Committee. The Council therefore proposes that four of its national officers become members of the Steering Committee of National Citizens Political Action Committee and that fifteen of its members be asked to join the National Executive Council of National Citizens Political Action Committee. They further propose that their member organizations shall receive all materials which National Citizens Political Action Committee offer its state organizations, and that an effort will be made to bring these groups into active participation on behalf of the political action program of National Citizens Political Action Committee.

In order to handle this large group of organizations adequately it is proposed that an addition be made to the National Citizens PAC staff of some one who will be equipped to handle this work. It is further proposed that the expenses of this undertaking which will also include the salaries of whatever personnel is necessary be covered by a direct contribution to National Citizens Political Action Committee.

National Citizens PAC will cooperate with these organizations in fund raising.
