Dearest Margaret:

I'm leaving tomorrow for Berlin. My  
visas for China are ready - all. I've  
only to pack and go. I'll leave within  
a week. There I've a conference of our  
B. C. Committee and you look to look  
after before I leave. I'll write you once  
again before I leave.

Here - I've worked with my translator  
are representative, Julian Gumpertz, Viktoria  
Allee 17, who has power of attorney to act  
for me in all personal matters in Europe.  
I've seen Herta Riess many times and  
intend, if possible, to write an article  
before I go.

Herta Riess wishes to open a  
B. C. clinic here. The rooms she has  
are small & dark and are not  
fitted as examination rooms. She wishes  
to take two large rooms, & the 2  
assistants & start a regular B. C. clinic.  
She is doing good work. She wants  
about \$100 (M. 400) a month which together

with what she gets from the "Bund  
für Mitterschutz" would be sufficient.  
But she has no possibility of getting  
more money here, later, she says. I told  
her I'd put the matter before you  
and before our Committee in Berlin to  
see what could be done.

I'll write more later over the  
B.C. work in Berlin. The municipality  
has taken over B.C. work and has opened  
3 clinics - but each only 4 hours  
a week. The Municipality took over our  
lovely clinic. We were glad. But they  
do no scientific work as we wished.  
So we have opened a clinic in  
another workers' section, Reinickendorf, ~~at~~  
with Dr. Max Hodann and 2 other physicians  
in charge. Dr. Hodann is also a Health  
Commissioner. We're using your money  
for this clinic. There we do research  
work & statistical work also and intend  
to make it a laboratory as well.

~~At~~ The Municipal action happened  
after I left Berlin and I've first to  
return & see all the things in action.  
My chief work in Berlin will be that  
before I go. I've many proposals for our

Committee such as the following:

1. all-German propaganda for B.C. Clinics (our Committee still has the direction of the 3 municipal Clinics + all propaganda)
2. Sterilization to be introduced as here in Frankfurt.
3. Abortion assistance as here.
4. Help for the Frankfurt Clinic, - if not through us, then through the Intern. Workers' Aid.

The Committee wrote me for my support of a proposal to give money from our fund to Dr. Helena Stocker's "Bund für Mutterschutz." I refused flatly. When I return I shall, at the risk of open hostility from Dr. Stocker, refuse all help to her "Bund für Mutterschutz." I'm not interested, nor are you, in charity. I don't give a damn for help to unmarried mothers or other such. Our work & money is for B.C. pure & simple. Dr. Wolf stands by me in this. I've asked that all money we have be put into our new Clinic & laboratory & make it a research institute. Dr. Stocker is doing good work along her lines - but

There are many other people. Let them  
get money elsewhere, however. If I  
had my way, I'd put Dr. Stöcker  
off the Committee. But this is only  
for you, Margaret. She is a vain,  
egotistical woman and she is  
jealous of our work for fear her  
own will fall into the background.  
I'll settle all this in Berlin. I'll ask  
Dr. Wolf to take over my vote  
for the time being, unless we can  
find someone else. I'll discuss the  
prospects of Dr. Herta Riese being brought  
in, but it is difficult because of various  
things. She thinks ~~also~~ that Frankfurt and  
her Clinic should be the center of the  
Universe. Yet Berlin is a great city  
& a proletarian city.

I wrote you of my China trip.  
You have perhaps sent addresses. I  
intend to start a clinic in Shanghai  
before the year is out, if I can get  
proper physicians. Then from there I  
hope to start them in other Chinese  
cities. So give me all help possible.  
What is the address of Baroness Ishimoto  
in Tokyo?

I've the intention to live & work

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in China. I've borrowed money from  
~~Prof. Friday to go for a year, and~~  
~~hope to repay it all by what I~~  
~~write.~~

I'll send you my Shanghai address  
before I go. I request you to send me  
these the following:

1. 12-20 copies of your B. C. pamphlet  
(family limitation)
  2. a copy of that big volume  
you sent - Dr. Schminke - - for  
physicians, with methods, etc.
  3. Copies of all questionnaires used  
in your clinic these
  4. Anything in the way of literature  
that doctors can use or  
that could be translated  
into Chinese as propaganda.
