The Left-wing Labor (but anti-Stalinist) weekly Tribune looks at the British Tories: "The Tories, for example, went to war for one purpose only: to end the military menace of Germany. They had no quarrel with the Nazis so long as Nazi activities confined themselves to destroying Liberal and Democratic institutions in Germany. Even when Germany became militarily strong they remained unperturbed as long as they were convinced that the goal of the Nazis was the destruction of Soviet power... It is necessary to keep this always in mind or we shall fail to understand what has been happening since the Allied Armies secured their lodgement on the Continent. From that even onwards the British Tories have been convinced of the ultimate overthrow of the Nazis. Once convinced of that, the original impulsion which drove them to make war began to lose its force. From that point on they have begun to wage the war with a divided purpose."
