## SHIFT CODE FOR CHINESE STUDENTS IN AMERICA

CHUNGKING (AP)—Three government spokesmen promised to recommend revision of regulations governing Chinese students abroad, which prompted a Harvard group to advocate the disbarment of Chinese from American universities, so as to correct a "misrepresentation" that thought control was the object.

The counsellor of the executive Yuan, Chang Ping-Chun, said what was actually intended by the regulations issued by the education ministry Nov. 14, 1943, was not thought control but "guidance of thought and control of conduct."

He and Minister of Information Liang-Han-Chao and Vice-Minister of Foreign Affairs K. C. Wu said no one could quarrel with this.

The regulations provided for observation of "the thought and conduct" of Chinese students abroad by a special supervisory

bureau and threatened students would be brought back to China if "their speech or conduct is contrary to the teachings of San Min Chui—Sun Yat Sen's three people's principles."

Wu said the supervisory system, enforced when he was at Princeton in the early 1920s, did not trouble him as the purpose was to insure that the moral behavior of the students should not disgrace them or China.
