Piano

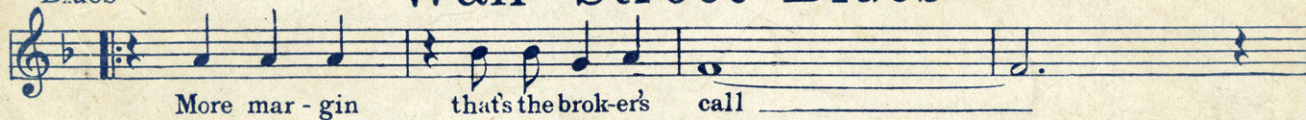
