**Chimes At Twilight.**  
 Reverie.

This beautiful and fascinating Chime Effect can best be obtained by a Light Staccato Touch from the wrist taking care to strike the notes in both hands precisely together. The piece starts and ends with the beautiful Chime Melody as tolled hourly by the Westminster Abby Chimes at London. It also introduces one of the best known hymns with Chime Effects. All other strains are to be played in marked contrast, legato and arpeggio (Broken Chords.)

The piano introduction is in 3/4 time, marked *f* (forte). It features a melody in the right hand and a supporting bass line in the left hand, both in the key of D major.






