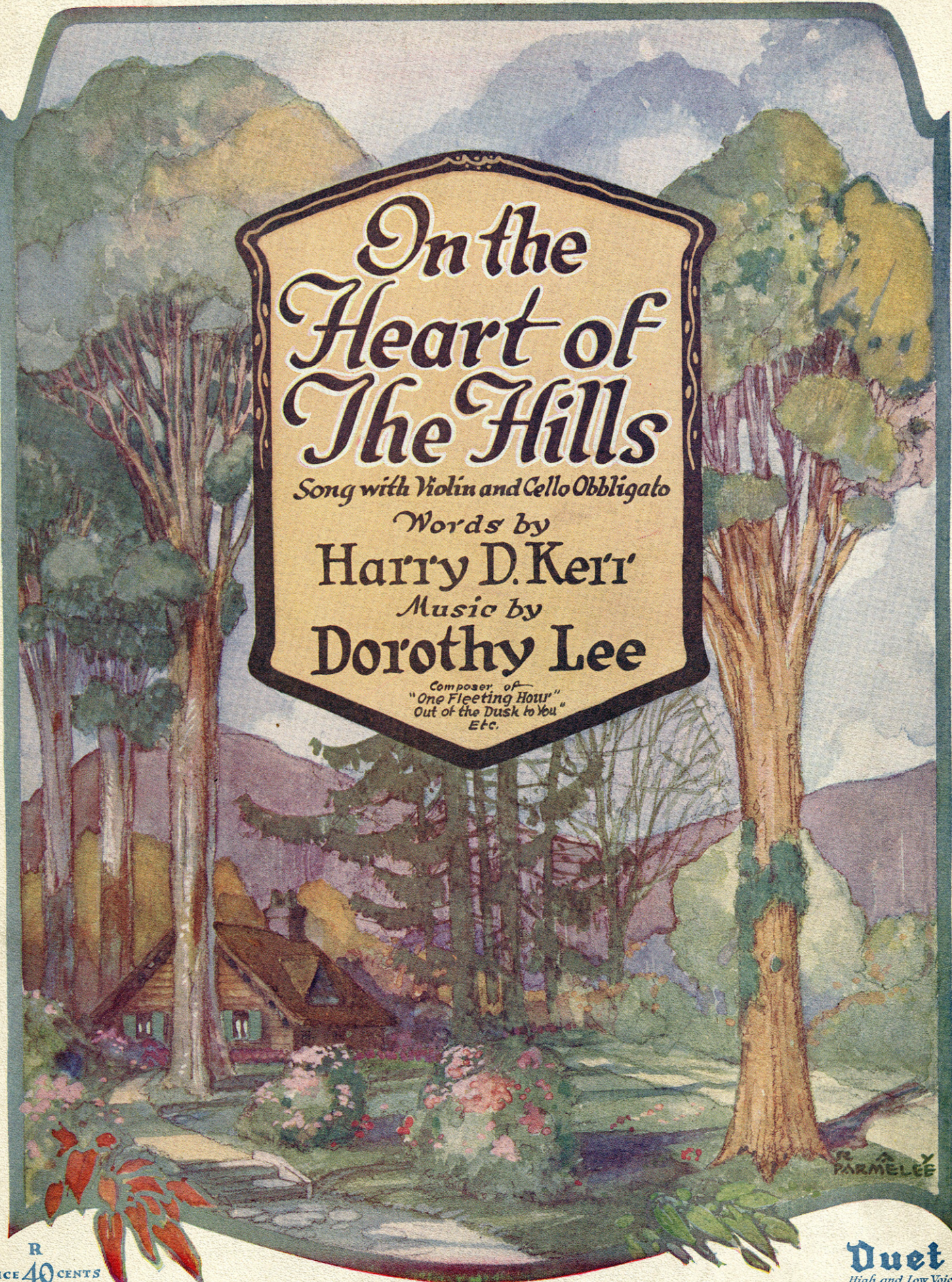

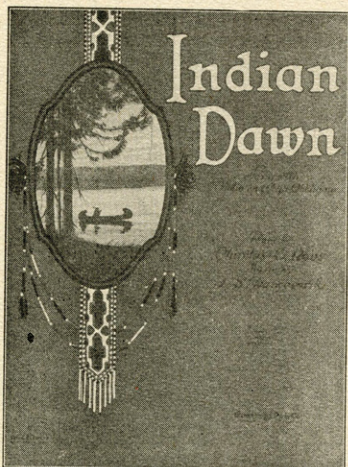

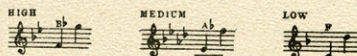
Dawn wind sighs;

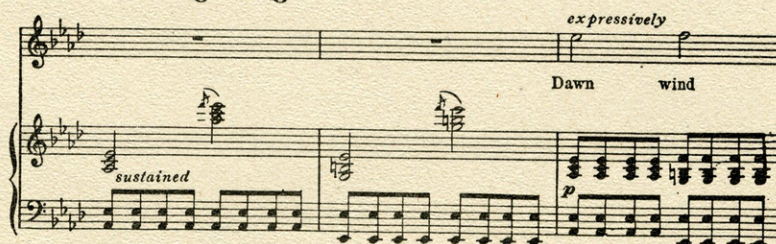
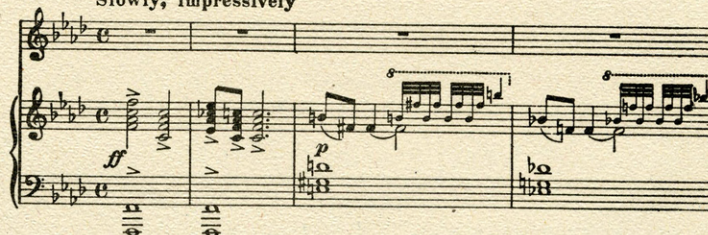

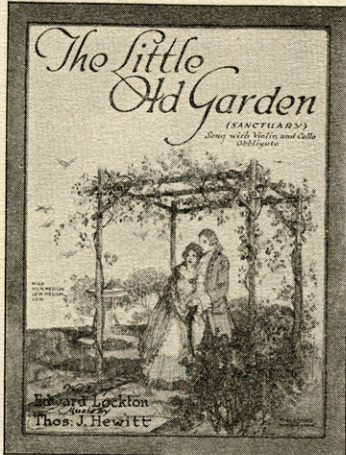

there with you.

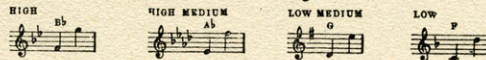
