



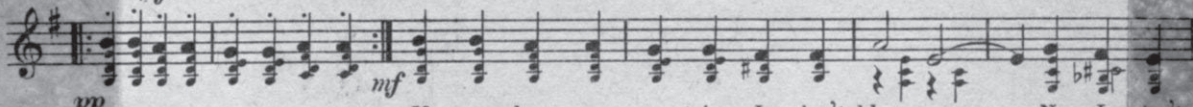
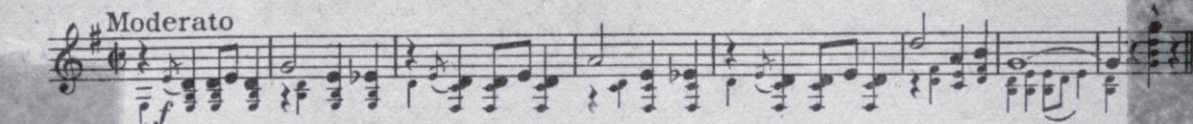

ar - gue — In fact I don't — But I just lay the sim-ple facts be-

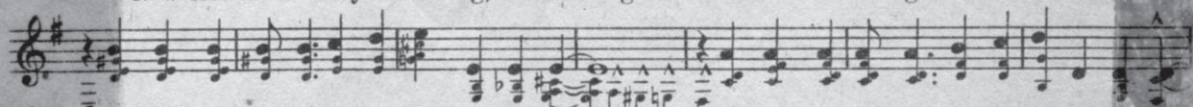
tell you, I've got to tell you — to get in line. — Say!

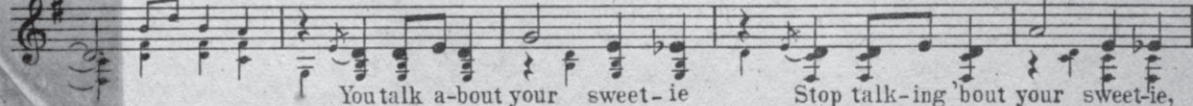


You talk a-bout your sweet-ie, Stop talk-ing 'bout your sweet-ie, Let's talk a-bout
