The piano introduction is in 2/4 time, featuring a melody in the right hand and a bass line in the left hand. It begins with a forte (*f*) dynamic and concludes with a sforzando (*sfz*) accent.

VOICE

The first vocal line begins with the lyrics: "A lone-some boy was pin-ing for the ones that he loved I just re-ceived a let-ter from this boy a-cross the". The piano accompaniment is marked *p* (piano) and includes the instruction "Till ready".

The second vocal line continues with the lyrics: "best, His thoughts were all of those he left be-hind The eve-ning sun was sink-ing in the sea, He writes: 'Don't wor-ry, ev-ry-thing is fine I've met all my pals, we're like a".

The third vocal line continues with the lyrics: "far off gold-en west, Which brought fond rec-ol-lec-tion to his mind And as he sat and hap-py fam-i-ly, We treat each oth-er, oh, so good and kind But ev-ry day just". The piano accompaniment includes the instruction *rall.* (rallentando).

The fourth vocal line concludes with the lyrics: "dreamed of days gone by, I heard him soft-ly whis-per with a sigh: as the sun goes down, I can't help but think of my home town." The piano accompaniment includes the instruction *a tempo* and features a *sfz* (sforzando) dynamic at the end.
