By law, most public places and places of employment in Arizona are required to post the required **"No Smoking"** signs at every entrance.

**Business proprietors** have the option of ordering signage free of charge OR creating their own "No Smoking" signs. To meet the signage requirements of the Smoke-Free Arizona Act § 36-601.01, the proprietor shall post signs that contain the following:

- Sign Requirement Information:**
- The international no smoking symbol (consisting of a pictorial representation of a burning cigarette enclosed in a red circle with a red bar across it) or the words "No Smoking"
  - A citation to A.R.S. § 36-601.01
  - The telephone number for making complaints (1-877-4-AZNSMOKE, 1-877-429-6676), and
  - The website address for making complaints ([www.smokefreearizona.org](http://www.smokefreearizona.org))

## Type of Signs

- [1] 4"x6" English
- [2] 4"x6" English with 20' Rule
- [3] 4"x6" English/Spanish
- [4] 4"x6" English/Spanish with 20' Rule
- [5] 4"x12" English with 20' Rule
- [6] 2"x3" Vehicle Sticker

For public places or places of employment, signs should be no smaller than 4 inches by 6 inches; and for business vehicles, signs should be no smaller than 2 inches by 3 inches.
