# Special Assembly Set For Tuesday

A special meeting of faculty and students of the University has been called for Goodwin Stadium at 10:45 a.m. Tuesday, Nov. 26, by President G. Homer Durham.

The president announced that Dr. Paul G. Hubbard will address the gathering on "Lessons From History." His address will include thoughtful comment on the recent tragic events in the United States, the meanings of them and the lessons to be learned therefrom, the president said.

Ceremonies will begin promptly at 10:45 a.m. from a platform in front of the stadium's East Stands. The college deans, school directors and other dignitaries will be seated there facing students and faculty in the East stands.

Following the playing of "The Star Spangled Banner" and the invocation, Dr. Durham will introduce Dr. Hubbard, whose address will follow. The assembly will dismiss promptly at 11:15 a.m.

Only 10:40 a.m. classes will be dismissed for this special assembly. The regular class schedule will be followed

otherwise on Tuesday, the president said.

In other developments over the weekend, the ASU-Idaho game scheduled for Saturday night was cancelled and will not be re-scheduled. Ticket holders may pick up refunds starting Tuesday morning by presenting their tickets to the ASU ticket office in the Men's Gymnasium.

President Durham announced Saturday that unclaimed refunds will be turned over to the United States Olympic Fund "as a commemorative tribute to President Kennedy . . . (this was) a project strongly supported by the nation's late Chief Executive."

Regular schedules of classes and activities will resume at ASU on Tuesday, with the exception of the special assembly at 10:45 a.m. at the Stadium.

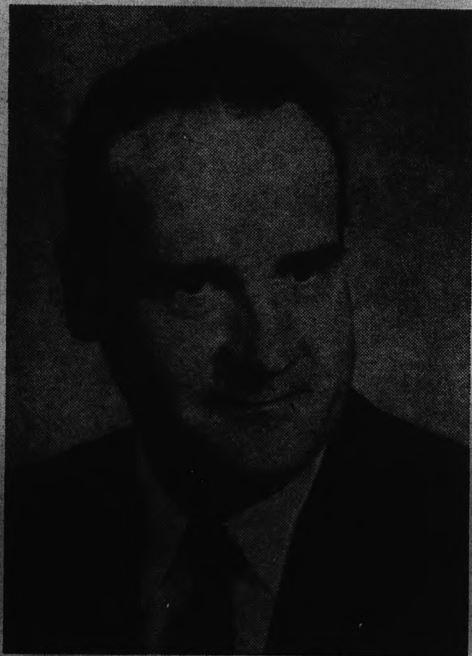
## Classes, Activities To Resume Schedule

Regular class schedules and activities will resume at 7:40 a.m. Tuesday at Arizona State University, according to President G. Homer Durham, following the national day of mourning Monday for the late President of the United States, John F. Kennedy.

Make-up performances for the Friday and Saturday night cancellations of the University Players' production of "Lysistrata" will be Dec. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7. Patrons may transfer tickets or pick up refunds at the ticket office in the Lyceum building.

No information is as yet available on possible re-scheduling of other cancelled activities, which include Senior Day and a High School Symposium of Dance on Saturday, and a faculty wives' theater party to the Phoenix Little Theater originally scheduled for Friday.

The Class AA High School Championship football game between Mesa and South Mountain High Schools, originally scheduled Friday night in Sun Devil Stadium, will be played Wednesday night. Game time is 8 p.m.
