DICK: Well, I needed a job, and I figured after all the times I've been stepped on, I know shoes better than anybody.

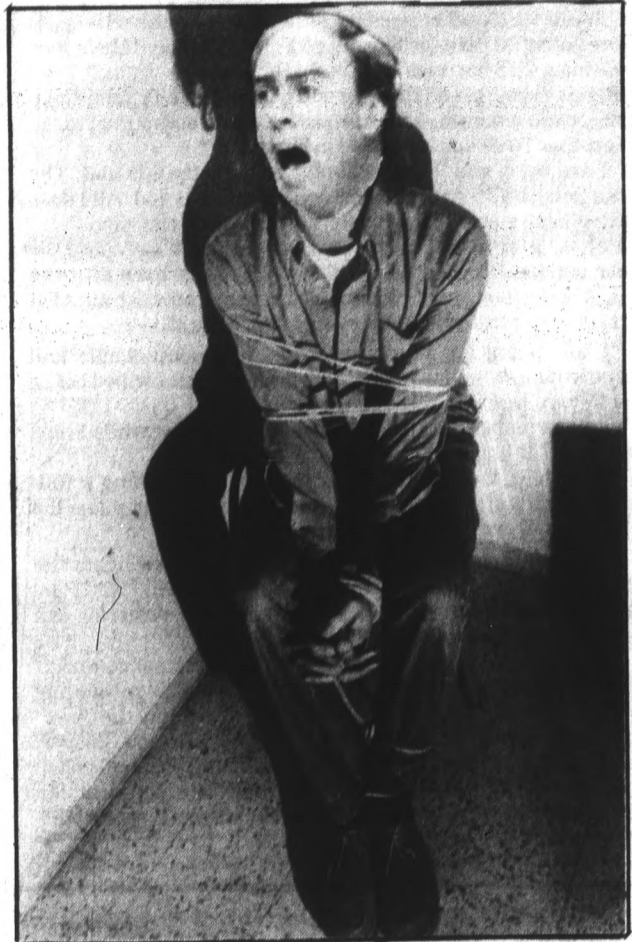
Dean went on to buy his shoes (at Buster Brown's), and Tamburo has dropped out of sight again.

# 'God' Pelvis draws fine for McWoman-style hat

ASU's wildman cheerleader/tee chaser "Pelvis" was fined \$5,000 Monday after months of appeals for wearing a CBS hat on the sidelines of the ASU-Washington game last Nov. 9.

The decision, handed down by NCAA Executive Director Faulty Tires, is the first since the infamous headband incident Jim McWoman encountered during the NFL playoffs in December.

Tires called the decision a "terribly vital move" because Pelvis's "messiah-like tendencies" could virtually start a new trend.

"Pelvis is a god at Arizona State," Tires said. "He's got more potential than the San Diego Fried Chicken. If he's seen wearing a CBS hat, kiss NBC and ABC goodbye."

Pelvis, interviewed late Monday night while sweeping the floor outside Playden Library, said he didn't even own the hat. A water boy gave it to him as a replacement for his ASU hat, which he lost while retrieving a tee, he said.

"I was going for a new record — four somersaults and three windpipe toe-jammers," Elvis said. "But I wiped out at the 35-yard line and my hat blew away."

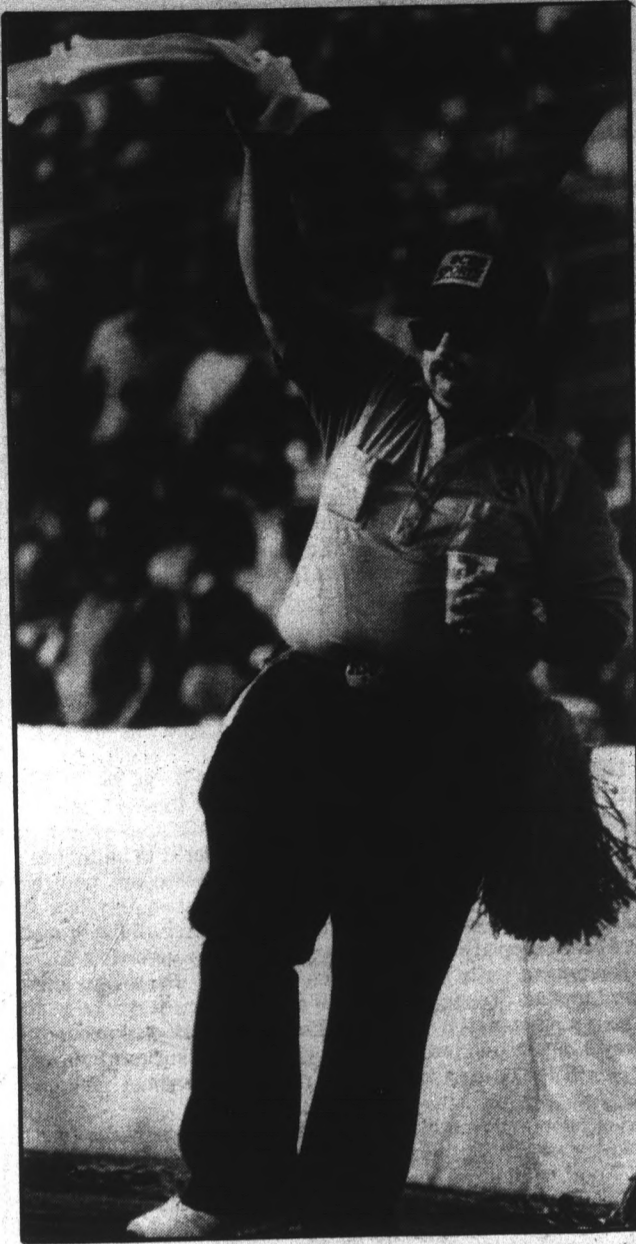
"I was crushed. Frank Cushy once kicked me while I was wearing that hat."

Meanwhile, the Pacific-10 Conference is launching a full-scale investigation of the incident in an attempt to place the ASU football program on probation.

"This is almost as serious as the free paperweights the ASU basketball coach gave to a high school coach," said Pac-10 Executive Director Tom "Charles" Manson, referring to a recent ASU basketball recruiting violation.

ASU athletic director Charles Hairless would not comment on the matter, but said the athletic department is sponsoring a "Save Your Pelvis" fundraiser to help Pelvis pay the fine.

Hairless said interested persons can pay \$1 to see Bloop, basketball coach Grieve Pitter-Patterson and baseball coach Jim Crock imitate Pelvis's tee-fetching techniques at Sin Devil Stadium this weekend. For more information, dial 965-PELV.
