My story's gonna be, all those people that work in the catering section of the starship, and the other people who work in the hospital, because their problems are not even of their own making [...] And so, a good example of that is when I did Wizards, I purposely chose them to have a not successful sandwich shop...

And sometimes forces bear against us. But one thing that's free, and that no one can take is laughter. And then I had an amazing teacher. Who taught me improv in Chicago when I was in Second City...

Dean Moriarty was one of these real Hellraisers, drinking, and just a crazy person. [...] So Jennifer Stone, had several lines in the show where she was like, I don't trust this guy. You know, I think he's up to no good...

I think it's okay to overcorrect early in your career. It sounds almost like I'm saying don't resist when most of my interview is about resisting. But I would say it's okay. Because you will find your voice. But you may only find your voice, if you continue to expand it, and bring it back into center...

Can you talk a bit about your own fascination with the zine format?

Yeah, it's not a fascination. I lived it. Like, in the '80s, this is how we found out about bands, and this is how we found out about stuff. You know, when I was young, I was an anarchist, and I was a socialist in the streets, and trying to get them to make an MLK day, a holiday, and it was how we communicated.

The Collection:

For the Paris-based designer, this collection was more than a coveted assignment; it was a culmination. From early assistant jobs learning the quiet rigor of luxury, to launching a cult label built on Tumblr-age sensuality, lace-up briefs, and queer, body-focused imagery, Ludovic de Saint Sernin has spent his career refining a single obsession: how fabric frames desire. That fixation met its grandest stage in “Le Naufrage” (The Shipwreck), a couture saga of sirens, sailors, corsets, and rope that read like his autobiography inside Jean Paul Gaultier’s world—where Gaultier’s legacy of erotic, rule breaking couture and Ludovic’s intimate style finally collided.

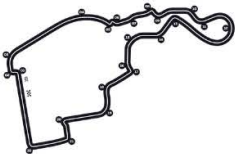

THE FILM INDUSTRY HAS A WIDE RANGE OF ROLES, FROM CREATIVE DEVELOPMENT TO HIGHLY SPECIALIZED TECHNICAL, LOGISTICAL, AND POST-PRODUCTION JOBS. I WANT TO TAKE A MOMENT TO HIGHLIGHT A FEW LESSER-KNOWN POSITIONS THAT ARE NOT ONLY ESSENTIAL TO FILMMAKING, BUT ALSO REALLY INTERESTING.



CREATIVE PRODUCER



Shapes the overall vision of a project, working closely with the director and writers to develop the story, tone, and style. They help guide creative decisions throughout production while also handling some logistical and financial aspects to make sure the vision is actually achievable.

Kevin Feige - An American film and television producer AND the president of Marvel Studios

GAFFER



Head of the lighting department and responsible for designing and executing the film's lighting setup. They work closely with the cinematographer to create the right mood, exposure, and visual style using lights and electrical equipment.

Jim Plannette - A "legendary" Hollywood gaffer known for his work on classics like Young Frankenstein, E.T., Braveheart, and Legends of the Fall.

FOLEY ARTIST



Creates and records everyday sound effects (like footsteps, clothing movement, or objects handling) in post-production. These sounds are synced to the visuals to make scenes feel more realistic and immersive.

Jack Donovan Foley - An American sound effects artist who was THE developer of many sound effect techniques used in filmmaking.

Fashion Designer Westwood, Vivienne



VIVIENNE WESTWOOD

Vivienne Westwood's youthful spirit of innovation led to her creating clothes that would change society. With her partner, Malcolm McLaren, she was pronounced in 1974 for the post-punk images she used in T-shirts she was selling at her King's Road shop. A year later she designed the first "Anarchy" shirt which depicted punk rock and the look adopted by the Sex Pistols, who were managed by McLaren. She has become increasingly interested in historical dress and launched a new series of her creations in 1988. Her recent collections have combined a love of English tradition with the flare of 18th- and 19th-century French dress.

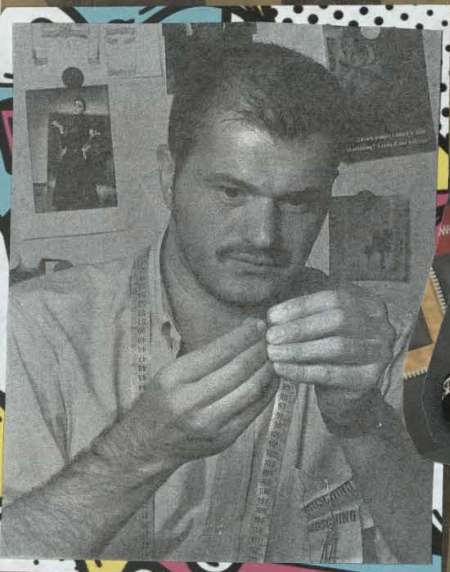
