Dr. Robert C. Fleming, Associate Director of Bands at Arizona State University, has degrees from Indiana University of Pennsylvania, Carnegie-Mellon University, and Southern Illinois University (Doctor of Philosophy in Secondary Education). Professor Fleming is Director of the nationally recognized Sun Devil Marching Band, the Concert Band, the Sun Devil Basketball Pep Band, the Olympic Sports Band, and the Phoenix Cardinals Pep Band. Before coming to Arizona State University in 1974, he was Director of Bands at the University of Tennessee at Martin, for seven years.

In addition to his duties at ASU, he is active as a marching/concert band clinician and adjudicator. He is a member of numerous professional organizations, and was elected to the Board of Directors of the American Bandmasters Association in 1990. He is Past President of the PAC 10 Band Directors Association and Past National President of the National Band Honorary Fraternity, Kappa Kappa Psi. Dr. Fleming was recently installed as an honorary member of the Alpha Chapter of Phi Beta Mu, the International Bandmasters Fraternity.
