•Philippe Langlet•

Philippe Langlet, one of Europe's leading band conductors, is Director of *L'Orchestre d'Harmonie de la Ville du Havre, France*. In 1986, his youth band took First Prize at the International Band Competition in Spain. In 1972, Langlet entered the Paris Conservatory as a student of Maurice Andre, and graduated several years later with a coveted Prize. Professionally, he has played solo trumpet with the French Marine Band, and trumpet with *L'Orchestre de Paris* under the baton of conductors Lorin Maazel, Claudio Abbado, and Daniel Barenboim. In 1974, he was named Professor of Trumpet at the National Conservatories of *Le Havre* and *Notre Dame de Gravenchon*. In 1990, he organized one of the largest Wind Music Festivals in Europe, *Coups de Vents*, featuring many of the greatest bands in the world.

•Richard E. Strange•

Dr. Richard E. Strange, Professor of Music, is in his eighteenth year as Director of Bands. In the past he has conducted, judged or given clinics in Canada, Japan, The Netherlands, England, Guam, New Zealand and France. For many years, he has been active in the community orchestra field, and currently is Music Director of the Tempe Symphony Orchestra. Dr. Strange (elected to the American Bandmasters Association in 1968) is a Past President of that organization. He is also Past President of the College Band Directors National Association. In December of this year, he was the 16th Symphonic Band Conductor in the United States (since the award's inception in 1963) to receive the "Distinguished Service to Music Medal" given by Kappa Kappa Psi, the National Honorary Band Fraternity. Also, in December, he was awarded the "Citation of Excellence" by the National Band Association for his "outstanding contribution to bands and band music."

Dr. Robert C. Fleming, Associate Director of Bands at Arizona State University, is director of the nationally recognized Sun Devil Marching Band, the Concert Band, and the Sun Devil Basketball Pep Band. In addition to his duties at Arizona State University, he is active as a marching and concert band clinician and adjudicator. He is on the Board of Directors of the American Bandmasters Association and Kappa Kappa Psi, the National Honorary Band Fraternity (President in 1987-89). Dr. Fleming is an honorary member of the Alpha Chapter of Phi Beta Mu, International Bandmasters Fraternity. This year, the Sun Devil Marching Band received the Sudler Trophy, given by the John Philip Sousa Foundation for making important contributions to the advancement of the performance standards of college marching bands over a period of years.
