Robert J. Campo, Jr. is a Masters of Music student in Choral Education at Arizona State University. He completed his Bachelor's Degree of Music in Music Education with a choral emphasis at the University of Puget Sound in Tacoma, Washington. Robert has participated in several professional choirs, studied voice under William Mouat at the Seattle Opera, and taken conducting from Dr. Paul Schultz, director of the Adelpian Concert Choir.

Mark Simmons is pursuing his DMA in Choral Music at Arizona State University. He holds a bachelor of Music Education degree from Ithaca College and a Master of Music degree in conducting from Eastman School of Music. He taught instrumental and choral music for three years in Medford, Oregon while also conducting a church choir and acting as assistant conductor for the Rogue Valley Chorale. He has been in master classes with Kenneth Jennings, Doreen Rao, and Helmuth Rilling.

Bart Shanklin, a doctoral student in the Choral Conducting program at ASU, has been Director of Choral Activities and Music Chairman for the past eight years at Southern Utah University. Prior to this position he served as Director of Choral Activities at the University of Arkansas at Monticello for three years, and as Choral Director at Blue Mountain College in Mississippi for five years. He holds the Bachelor of Music degree from Union University, Jackson Tennessee, and the Master of Music degree from Florida State University. In addition he has done doctoral study at the University of Illinois in both choral music and voice performance.
