*Elizabeth Buck is currently in her sixth season as principal flutist with the Phoenix Symphony. Elizabeth also performs with the Manhattan Wind Quintet and the Grand Teton Music Festival. Prior to moving to Arizona, she performed with the Houston Grand Opera, the New York City Opera National Company, and the Nova Philharmonia of Portugal. Elizabeth studied with Samuel Baron and Carol Wincenc at The Juilliard School, receiving both her bachelor's and master's degrees. Most recently, she studied at the Shepherd School of Music at Rice University, working towards completion of her doctoral degree.*

*As a soloist, Elizabeth has performed numerous concerti with the Phoenix Symphony, and has given recitals for the National Flute Association, the Arizona Flute Society, Arizona State University and Northern Arizona University. Within the greater Phoenix community, she has given talks and lectures for Borders Books and Music, Brandeis Women's Club, Phoenix Symphony Music Education League, the PLace, and Spirit of the Senses. Across the national front, she has won top prizes in the New York Flute Club Competition, the New York National Arts Club Competition, and the Juilliard School Concerto Competition. She has performed in Alice Tully Hall as soloist with the Juilliard Chamber Orchestra, and she has had the honor of appearing with Jean Pierre Rampal and Julius Baker in Carnegie Hall.*

*Elizabeth enjoys playing chamber music with the Manhattan Wind Quintet, giving recitals, master classes and workshops in chamber music throughout New York, Connecticut and Pennsylvania. The MWQ released their first recording of American contemporary works, entitled *When Angels Speak*, on the Albany Record label in 1996.*

*When not performing, traveling or teaching, Elizabeth enjoys hiking, gardening, cooking, and playing on the computer.*
